The Town of Clinton Summer Recreation Program will meet at Clinton Public School. The program will run from **Monday - Friday from June 29th - July 24th**. Registration will be open to all children who have completed kindergarten through grade 7.

HOURS OF OPERATION

The Parks and Playgrounds Commission would like to announce that they are extending enrollment possibilities to meet the needs of our working parents. Please see below for your enrollment options: (Pricing is listed in the pricing section.)

- Full Day Registration: 9am-4pm
- ½ Day AM Registration: 9am-12noon
- Morning Care: 7:30am-9am
- Extended Day Care: 4:00pm-5:30pm
- Weekly registration and 4 week registration options are available
- NOTE: Daily Glen Gardner busing is still available this year but **ONLY** for the ½ Day AM Registration. Any morning care, extended care, or full-day registrations are the responsibility of the parent. If you register your child for the Full-Day then your child can take the bus to CPS in the morning only.

WHEN DOES REGISTRATION BEGIN?

- Program Registration Enrollment **opens** on Monday, January 13th. (All forms are included in this packet. There is no online registration available this year.)
- Program Registration Enrollment **closes** on **Friday, February 14th**. (Forms must be received by 4pm at the Town Hall building in order to be considered on time.)

(Please do not send any forms to Clinton Public School with your child.)

- **A late registration fee of \$50 per family will be applied if registering after February 14th.**
- The program is open to all students who are currently in kindergarten through 7th grade.
- Financial assistance is available for those who qualified for the 2019-2020 Clinton Public School free/reduced lunch program. Please contact me **prior** to sending in your registration for approval and cost.
- Your cancelled check is your enrollment confirmation, or you can contact me to confirm.

NEW THIS YEAR: TRIP REGISTRATION

- **SAVE THE DATE: Thursday, March 19th from 6-8pm**, is the **only** opportunity to sign your child up for any of the trips listed on the calendar. You **must** come in person to register your child for the trips of their choice. Registration for trips will be held at the Town Hall in the meeting room.
- There is a **cap** on the number of students allowed to attend certain trips (noted in the trips section of the packet). For those trips, it is a first-come, first-serve situation.
- Bring **THIS** packet with you - minus the registration forms, which you've already mailed in, and to the Trip Registration Night.

PHOTO PERMISSION

Photos of students and activities will be posted on our **Facebook page: 2020 Town of Clinton Summer Recreation Program**. Enrolling your child in our program automatically gives us the right to post photographs on the page. No names will be posted with photos.

CODE OF CONDUCT

In order to ensure the safety and enjoyment of the Town of Clinton Summer Recreation Program for all persons involved, children must comply with the expectations listed below:

- Use of appropriate language – no cursing
- Comply with the bus rules established by the bus driver
- Stay in the designated areas of the school
- Display respect toward staff members and fellow registrants
- Display respect to the school property and items belonging to the recreation program
- Respect items that belong to others

Failure to comply with the above expectations will result in removal from the program, with no refund issued.

MEDICAL NEEDS/CONCERNS

- If your child has a food allergy or requires an Epi-Pen for any reason, note the Town of Clinton Summer Recreation Program is **NOT** responsible for administering an Epi-Pen. An ambulance would be called if the need arises. You are welcome to follow along on a trip if you would feel more comfortable.
- The school nurse is available from 9-12, Monday-Thursday **ONLY**.
- If your child needs medical attention for any reason other than a bandaid - parents and an ambulance will be notified immediately.

DROP-OFF AND DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

- If you are participating in the Morning Care Program, you should drop your child off at the main office doors.
- If your child is participating in the ½ Day AM or Full Day that begin at 9am, you should drop them off at the 2nd set of double-doors.
- If you are picking your child up at noon, you will need to sign them out on the back hill (near playground), unless it is raining, then a counselor will open the 2nd set of double-doors to allow you into the gym for sign out.
- If you are picking your child up at 4:00 or from the extended care program, you will need to call the number we will be providing you with to have a counselor let you into the building near the main office.
- Children will have the option of walking home from Recreation during the AM session ONLY.
- Busing for the ½ Day AM Program from Glen Gardner is still available. You will be emailed with information about the stop locations and pick-up/drop-off times once all registration has been completed.
- There is NO busing available to and from Glen Gardner for the Morning Care, Full-Day (afternoon), or Extended Day Programs.

BEFORE & EXTENDED CARE PRICING

7:30am-9:00am & 4:00pm-5:30pm

- **Before Care and Extended Care Combo: Week 1 only:** \$28 per week/camper. 2+ children \$18 per week/camper. **Weeks 2-4:** \$30 per week/camper. 2+ children are \$20 per week per camper.
- **Before Care Only: Week 1 only:** \$13 per week/camper. 2+ children \$8 per week/camper. **Weeks 2-4:** \$15 per week/camper. 2+ children are \$10 per week/camper.
- **Extended Care Only: Week 1 only:** \$13 per week/camper. 2+ children \$8 per week/camper. **Weeks 2-4:** \$15 per week/camper. 2+ children are \$10 per week/camper.
- There are **NO** daily rates.

½ DAY REGISTRATION PRICING (9am-12noon)

Note prices are reflective of the increased costs in NJ's minimum wage requirements, and increased costs for supplies.

- **Weekly Rate** - \$75 per week per child (Exception Week 1 is \$70 per child)
- **4 Week Discounted Rate for 1st Child** - \$250
- **4 Week Discounted Rate for 2nd+ Subsequent Children** - \$225 per child

FULL DAY REGISTRATION PRICING (9am-4pm)

Note prices are reflective of the increased costs in NJ's minimum wage requirements, and increased costs for supplies.

- **Weekly Rate** - \$150 per week per child (\$130 for Week 1 only)
- **4 Week Discounted Rate for 1st Child** - \$560
- **4 Week Discounted Rate for 2nd+ Subsequent Children** - \$500 per child

- **All trips/workshops are priced at a per person cost. There are no discounts for families with multiple children or for those on the free/reduced lunch program.**

ADDITIONAL HAPPENINGS THAT REQUIRE EXTRA EXPENSES

Kona Ice (Kindergarten -7th grade): Kona Ice offers refreshing shaved ice where the kids get to choose their own flavors to create the perfect Kona Ice. The cost of a kiddie 8 oz. Kona Ice is \$2.00. The cost of a regular 12 oz. Kona Ice is \$3.00. The cost of a 16 oz. King Kona is \$4.00. Kona Ice also offers prepaid cards at the following cost: \$9.00 each, with a value of \$12.00. These cards can be used throughout Summer Rec, as well as, anytime you see the Kona truck in your neighborhood. (Do NOT send money in for Kona Ice prior to the start of Summer Rec. This is a cash only transaction with Kona Ice. If you'd like to send in money in a marked envelope with your child, I will be sure to give it to the Kona Ice man.) *Notes:

1. Kona Ice does have the potential for nut allergies. If your child does have a peanut/nut allergy, they can still get a Kona Ice if **you** provide a specific juice that is safe for your child. You can send this flavoring to the Recreation Program and we will hold it for your child's use on the days of the Kona visit.
2. If you choose to purchase a Kona Ice card, Summer Recreation will hold your child's card for the weekly visits. (They will not have to worry about losing or forgetting them).
3. You do not have to purchase a card. You can send your child to Recreation with cash.

½ DAY AM RECREATION GAMES AND ACTIVITIES

- **3-LEGGED RACES (K-7):** Children will compete for prizes. The team to cross the finish line in each group will win a prize.
- **COOKIE FACE CONTEST (K-7):** Move a cookie from your forehead to your mouth without using your hands. First person to do it – wins a prize! (Note: Cookies may not be safe for peanut/tree nut children).
- **CLINTON FIRE DEPARTMENT HOSE DOWN (K-7):** Get ready to get soaked!!!! The fire department volunteers are an amazing group of people. Not only do they volunteer their time to keep us all safe, but to help us have a little bit of fun, too. They will be bringing a fire truck up to spray all the kids down. This is no joke – the kids will get SOAKED! Children must be prepared with a bathing suit and appropriate footwear. If your child does not want to participate, there will be a dry area for them to watch the fun.
- **WATER BALLOON TOSS (K-7):** Children will have fun tossing their water balloons to their partners and getting wet in the process. Winners from each group will get a prize.
- **BALLOON SQUASH/BUCKET DUMP (K-7):** At the end of almost everyday, we will sit on the hill behind the school and have the balloon squash and bucket dump. Names will be announced to sit on water balloons and to get buckets of water dumped on them. (If your child's name is called and they do not want to participate, they do not have to.)
- **MUSICAL CHAIRS (K-7):** An old-time, traditional game for all ages. Children will listen to the music and find a seat before everyone else. The last one sitting – wins a prize!
- **CUP RACE CONTEST (K-7):** Students will use a straw to see who can blow their cup across the finish line first. First person in each group will win a prize.
- **TIE-DYE DAY (K-7):** Children will each tie-dye their own shirts. **Please be sure to have your child bring a light colored t-shirt from home.**
- **BASKETBALL CONTESTS (4-7):** Children will participate in two free-throw contests: BEST OUT OF 10.
- **SUCK IT UP (K-7):** Children will compete to see who can be the fastest to transfer mini-marshmallows from one bowl to another – using only a straw and their mouth. First one to transfer all their marshmallows – wins a prize.
- **WACKY HAIR CONTEST (K-7):** Children will decorate their hair and compete for prizes in the following categories: Categories: MOST COLORFUL and MOST CREATIVE
- **ICE CREAM EATING CONTEST (K-7):** Get ready to get messy! Each grade level will compete for two prizes – Messiest and Neatest. **Make sure you wear appropriate clothing on this day if you are going to participate.**
- **BUBBLE GUM CONTEST (4-7):** The person to blow the biggest bubble in 60 seconds – wins a prize.
- **DODGEBALL TOURNAMENT (4-7):** Children will team up with fellow Summer Recreation friends to verse each other to win first place in this competition. Each member of the winning team will receive a prize.
- **EYES OF THE WILD (K-7):** An exciting 60 minute live animal presentation with approximately 5-6 animals. Some animals are exotic and at least one or two touchable animals.
- **PICNIC:** To conclude our last day children will feast on hot dogs, juice boxes, chips, cookies, and ice pops. **A special note to parents of children with food allergies:** You are welcome to send in alternate foods for our ice cream eating contest and our last day picnic. You are also welcome and encouraged to come in and check all food labels prior to those events. Summer Recreation Staff makes no guarantees for food allergy safety.

AFTERNOON EVENTS FOR FULL DAY RECREATION

- **LUNCH** - **Must** bring their own packed lunch each day. No refrigeration will be provided, so please pack accordingly (just like a normal school day). 12:15-12:45 each day - unless there is an extended day trip. Follow the information provided on those days for more details.
- **STEM:**
 - **Building Marshmallow Catapults** - using a variety of household objects, students will build their own catapults for launching marshmallows.
 - **Building a Volcano** - making their own clay and household items to create their very own volcano.
 - **Building a Gum Drop Bridge or Tower** - see how high you can make the tower or how long you can make the bridge before it falls down. (Gum drops will be used. If your child has a food allergy and cannot participate, please let us know.)
 - **100 Cup Tower Challenge** - Try to create a tower as high as possible using 100 cups - be careful it doesn't fall!
 - **Making Transportation** - using various items - food products included - to create their own form of transportation. (food allergies will be taken into consideration when buying supplies for this activity)
- **WET AND WILD** - Bring a bathing suit, towel, sunscreen on these days. Feel free to bring your own water squirter, too.
- **COOKING AT CAMP:**
 - **Brownie Batter Dip** - cream cheese, butter, confectioners' sugar, baking cocoa, 2% milk, brown sugar, vanilla extract, pretzels, and sliced apples
 - **Cheerios Marshmallow Bars** - butter, marshmallows, cheerios, and chocolate chips
 - **Banana Sushi** - banana, melted chocolate, sprinkles, rice krispies, and fruity pebbles
- **COOKING WITH ANNA:**
 - **Breakfast - Omelettes in a Bag** - eggs, cheddar or swiss cheese, ham, sausage, onions, mushrooms, red peppers, and tomatoes. (Note: Children do not have to use all of the ingredients - it will be based on their liking. If your child has a food allergy, other than eggs, we will do our best to make substitutions.)
 - **Lunch - Quesadilla Fiesta with Guacamole and Salsa** - corn or flour tortillas, cheddar and monterey jack cheese, cilantro, chicken, avocados, green onions, sour cream, tomatoes, limes, and salt. (Note: Children do not have to use all of the ingredients - it will be based on their liking. If your child has a food allergy, we will do our best to make substitutions.)
 - **Dinner - Zucchini Ravioli** - zucchini, ricotta, mozzarella, spinach, tomatoes, garlic, vidallia onions, parmesan cheese and basil (Note: Children do not have to use all of the ingredients - it will be based on their liking. If your child has a food allergy, we will do our best to make substitutions.)
 - **Dessert - Cat Poop in a Litter Box** - (silly name for a super, tasty treat) flour, cocoa powder, butter, sugar, eggs, vanilla, vanilla sponge cake, golden Oreo cookies, and light corn syrup. (Note: Children do not have to use all of the ingredients - it will be based on their liking. If your child has a food allergy, other than eggs, we will do our best to make substitutions.)
- **POPCORN AND A MOVIE:** The movie will be voted on by the group. All movie choices will be G or PG. The popcorn will be the buttered bagged popcorn from ShopRite.

REFUND POLICY

- Inappropriate behavior may involve disciplinary action by the camp supervisor and/or dismissal from camp. If a camper is dismissed for inappropriate behavior camp fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.
- There are NO REFUNDS if a scheduled Field Trip is cancelled.
- If your child chooses not to attend when they are registered (for camp or for a trip) NO REFUND will be given.

- **PLEASE NOTE:** If we are unable to reach an enrollment of **30** children in the full-day program, it will be **cancelled**. You **will** receive your money back. Please be sure to print your email address clearly on the registration form.

PERSONAL PROPERTY AND MONEY POLICY

Neither the recreation department nor the camp staff can be responsible for campers' personal property or money brought to recreation. Please encourage your child to not bring electronic devices (video games), toys, or any like items to camp. We understand that many of our campers are walkers and have cell phones for this purpose. Note that we will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to these items.

SNACK/FOOD POLICY

- For the safety of all our participants, children are **NOT** allowed to bring a snack to our program. There are specific days when food is brought in for events (check the calendars), but those are the only days when food is allowed.
