

## **Cafeteria Charge Policy**

**Name of Local Education Agency (LEA): Clinton Public School**

**Implementation Date: 5-24-23**

### **Policy:**

- If money is owed for breakfast or lunch, the district must contact the student's parent or guardian with a first notice of the debt. The parent or guardian has 10 school days to pay the amount due.
  - If the parent or guardian does not make a full payment by the end of the 10 school days, a second notice must be provided to the parent stating that breakfast or lunch, as applicable, will not be served to the student beginning one week from the date of the second notice unless the payment is made in full.
- Snacks or Milk charges will not be permitted.
- School staff cannot make exceptions to the policy.
- School food service staff at each school will be trained annually on this policy.
